

BREAM HERITAGE WALK - bhwalk.uk

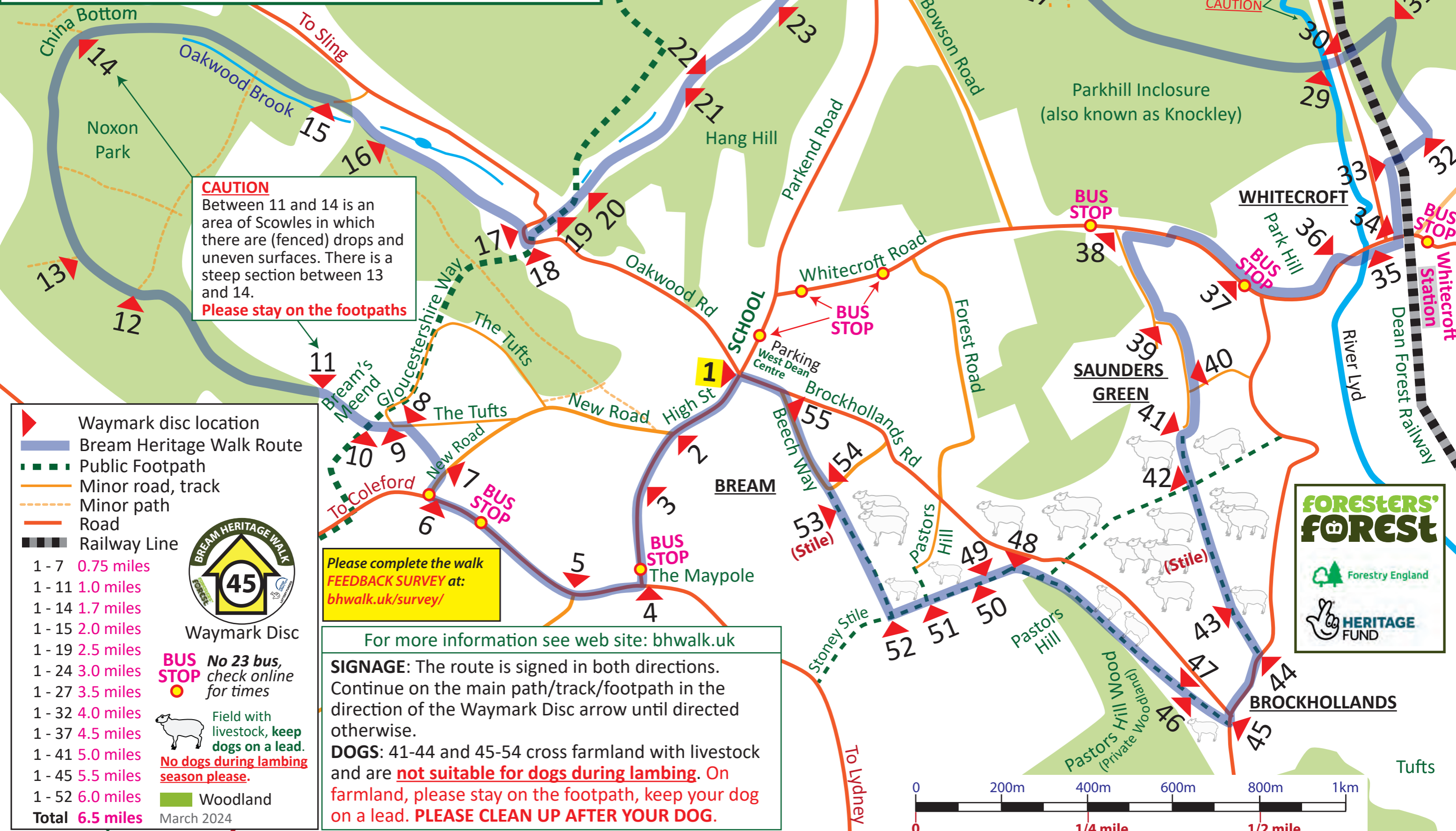
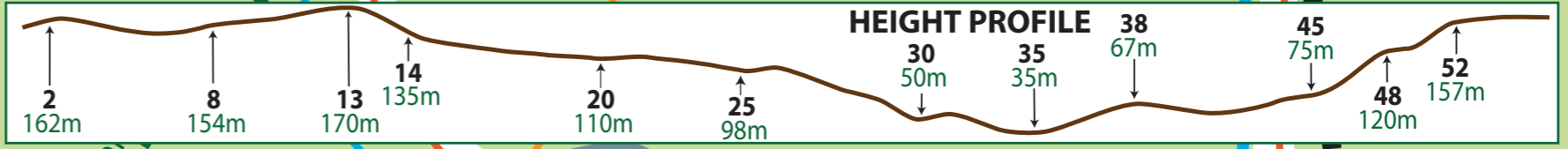
START: The walk starts and ends at "Bream Schools" - on Bream High St. at the start of Oakwood Road. The Postcode is GL15 6JW.

PARKING is available at the West Dean Centre near the school.

SHOPS: The walk passes shops, a pub and a cafe in Bream and a pub, and a chip shop/takeaway in Whitecroft.

STILES: There are currently two stiles: one between 42&43 and one at 53.

TOILETS: There are toilets at the West Dean Centre in Bream.



CAUTION
Between 11 and 14 is an area of Scowles in which there are (fenced) drops and uneven surfaces. There is a steep section between 13 and 14.
